The Eldridge Community has a strong history of showing its support for the Police Department and its officers. The City of Eldridge is one of the best places to live in Iowa, recently being recognized as the second safest city in Iowa, by Safewise. The City of Eldridge is an equal opportunity employer.

As of July 1st, 2023, starting salary for a certified officer is \$59,476.04, increasing after 1 year to \$61,260.32. Starting salary for non-certified officers begins at \$54,429.00. New officers are entitled to 24 hours of personal leave effective on the date of hire. Certified officers may be eligible for a \$3,000 hiring bonus.

The Eldridge Police Department offers a 3% step increase after 1, 3, 5, 7, and 10 years of service. The city offers a comprehensive benefits package that includes up to 4 weeks' vacation, IPERS retirement, health insurance, out of pocket maximum includes co pays and deductibles not to exceed \$325 for single or \$650 for family per year, dental and vision is also offered. The city also offers \$25,000 life insurance for non-probationary employees.

Physical testing will take place on Saturday, January 6th, 2023, at the North Scott YMCA at 0800 hours. The North Scott YMCA is located at 104 S 3rd Avenue, Eldridge, IA 52748.

Written testing will take place following the physical testing, Saturday, January 6th, 2023, at Eldridge City Hall. Eldridge City Hall is located at 305 N 3rd Street, Eldridge, Iowa, 52748.
