Agenda – Motion by Dockery to approve the agenda as presented, second by Cheek. Motion approved unanimously by voice vote.

- D. Consideration of Authorization to Fund Raise for the Eldridge Police Department K-9 Program. Motion by Blackwell to approve the fund raising, second by Cheek. Motion approved unanimously by voice vote.
