

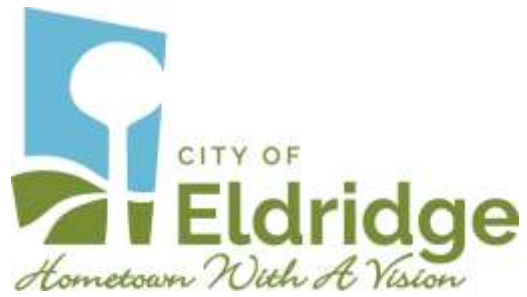

 - A. 21.5(1) (j) To discuss the purchase or sale of particular real estate only where premature disclosure could be reasonably expected to increase the price the governmental body would have to pay for that property or reduce the price the governmental body would receive for that property. The minutes and the audio recording of a session closed under this paragraph shall be available for public examination when the transaction discussed is completed.



- B. 21.5 (1)(i). To evaluate the professional competency of an individual whose appointment, hiring, performance, or discharge is being considered when necessary to prevent needless and irreparable injury to that individual's reputation and that individual requests a closed session.
- C. 20.17(3) To have negotiation sessions, strategy meetings of public employers, mediation, and the deliberative process of arbitrators for the Municipal Employees Association and will therefore adjourn into closed session.
